In Literature however, the "*mise en abyme*" (from the French "*put into the abyss*"), indicates a sort of history in history, or a small story within the main story that summarizes some of its aspects.

RITRATTI SENZ'ANIMA

(portrait without a soul)

Nowadays, interpersonal relations have changed and people meet and communicate through writing, in a world where visual and eye contact are increasingly rare connectors. It is said that the eyes are the windows to the soul, but what happens when it is exactly that which is missing? *"Ritratti senz'anima"* (portraits without souls) is a project composed of three portraits that represent the new generation and the current methods of communication and socialization, through Social Networks. If, before these systems made their appearance, our circle of acquaintances was practically limited to persons in our academic or work environment, today we can socialize with hundreds of people who, however, we have never physically met and who, for the most part, we never will meet, people who live far away from us or even in different countries. The fact that the nature of these "friendships" is fundamentally based on the written work, presents us with a distortion at the origin: the structure required in interpersonal relations fail the very moment in which visual contact is lacking, because without eye contact, there can be no real connection between two people, and the same may be said of the structure of the portrait which, missing eye contact, loses its essence to become, precisely, a portrait without a soul.



Among the processes used by Borges to create a fantasy effect in his tales, is the description of a work inside the work, through both intertextuality and paratextuality. Black and white photography, within the image, in fact signifies that we are before a fictional work. Two portraits, Morning and Evening, that recount two moments of the day that are intimately connected to dreams and therefore to a fantasy world which, in a certain sense, is a part of our lives, even if we have no control over what happens to us in our dreams and rarely can we bring back with us vivid memories of that world, but rather we come back with, if anything, a handful of sensations and a few fleeting images. If at dawn we are still touched by the experiences we have had in our dream world, in the evening we adore sunsets, ready to live new dreams.



A time comes in ones childhood when something happens, something changes: awareness of death is a disturbing discovery that somehow wipes away the innocence of existence in every child. Every mother, like her, wishes to stop time and cover her daughters eyes, in the impossible attempt to protect her from the wound that the awareness of death will open in her soul. In the same way, the child covers her mother's eyes, like a guardian angel who tries to hold back her tears, whispering words of comfort and urging her not to dwell on the thought. But death is there, it exists and it is an irreparable part of life. This is a well loved-theme in my native culture. In the Hispanic world, speaking of death and spirits is not a taboo, quite to the contrary. Almost as an attempt to charm it, death enters our homes and we speak of her openly.

In the mirror, our eyes seek out ourselves, but what would happen if in that space of solitary eye contact mirrors revealed themselves to the obvious multiplication of that which the eyes are sure to see? We would find ourselves contemplating our souls. But mirrors never show you your souls and, if by chance you should glimpse it, know that you are dreaming. According to Borges, there is not much difference between the act of dreaming and the act of poetry, seeing as both dreams and poetry can be generated or created by us. These images may be called oneiric as they have been created by me as if they were poems: mirrors do not reflect the reality of what stands before them, as we would expect, but instead, a surprising image that generates a perturbing sensation, similar to that created by certain dreams.

In dreams, we, all of us, generate a new world in our minds, which is the result of events we have lived during our waking hours. Oneiric images, created through photomontage techniques, imitate this process, displaying a new world made up of a non-existent reality, but that is the product of moments that have been actually captured. The result, like for dreams, is an attractive and linear image which, however, intends to provoke in us sensations that are both fleeting and perturbing.

The shudder, insofar as it is a primordial reaction, is something we have in common with animals. We have a survival instinct. Uncontrolled, it makes us frightened and makes us scream. The body is suddenly pervaded by involuntary movements the sole scope of which is to make us flee from danger. If the communication between individuals is not verbal, it is often involuntary and is nevertheless part of a flow of communication, an instinctive and sudden reaction has a very precise intention that is common to all species. Fear is an intrinsic instinct that all species on the planet share, humans included. Even in dreams, we may feel fear, fear towards something that we ourselves have created and that makes us shudder and even wake up. Here, we know we are looking at oneiric images because we can perceive that it is impossible for a dragonfly to land on a finger of that it not fly away when the woman screams. And the same is true of the bird, that would have flown to the woman's face. This would not happen in real life, unless the animal did not need to defend itself or its offspring.





BIOGRAPHY

Montserrat Diaz was born in Malaga, Spain, in 1976. She has been living in Milan since 2000, where she obtained her university degree in Foreign Languages and Literature and where she teaches Spanish as a second language for foreigners. She has always had a certain talent for painting, but photography is her preferred medium of self-expression. This passion for photography was born in 2014, and she began studying as an autodidact, cultivating the minimalist genre, to which she is keenly attracted. It was when she discovered photomontages that she began to explore other, more intimate and personal territories. The idea that life has the substance as dreams forms the basis of her conceptual thought, and through the use of photomontages, she strives to imitate the act of dreaming: dreams are a world created by us and in us, made of re-elaborated actual moments. They are a precious means of communications with our inner selves, through a shared symbolism. In the same way, Montserrat creates new, unreal scenarios, starting from “photographed pieces of reality” pieced together. A re-elaboration of reality that aims to create an image that that explore the meanders of the human soul, capable of generating a strong reaction in the audience. Her exhibitions began in 2016, when she participated in the Turin event Paratissima 12. From that moment on, her career took flight: In 2017, she won the selection call issued by Malamegi Lab and exhibited her works at the Galleria Imagoars in Venice, winning the first prize among the participants. That same year, the management of Paratissima selects one of her works for the graphics of the G@P (“Galleries at Paratissima”) catalogue and to promote the event, and offers her a space in the photography section of NoPhoto for Paratissima Torino. The works that she exhibited at that event won the Premio Galleria Bonetti prize and the Premio Mauto prize.

In 2018 she participated in both Paratissima Bologna I and Paratissima Milano I, the latter being the edition in which she won the PRS Talent Prize. She participated in the Sorrento Young Art festival, an artistic event curated by Paolo Feroce, and in the collective photographic exhibition curated by Martin Vegas held by ImagNation in Paris. Her first personal exhibit, entitled The oneiric photography of Montserrat Diaz, took place that same year in the DVO_ showroom in Milan, where exhibited a large number of her works. In October 2018, the Galleria Interni Bonetti hosted her second personal exhibit. In 2019, the Galleria FIAF Photoclub EYE BFI in Felice sul Panaro (Modena) hosted her third personal exhibit. In the meantime, she participated in various collective exhibits and collaborated with the magazine Fuoriasse, a literary cooperative, and with Studio Ata/Plan Buy®/Barbara Corsico photography.
